

We recomend removing the original exhaust from the car before cutting.

Locate the sets of indents on both sides of the original system.

Cut the system through the middle pair of indents. Once cut de-bur the edges and re-fit the front to the car

Estimated Fitting Time: 2 Hours





- A) Remove the electronic actuator from the original exhaust.
- B) On the scorpion product fit the fixing bow (item 13) into the valve and use the actuator to secure the bow in place.
- C) Use the original bolts to fasten the actuator to the valve ensuring the two straights on the fixing bow fit between the grooves on both of the posts.
- D) For easier fitting we recommend assembling the rear trim pipes and rear silencer (items 3,4 and 5)
- E) Secure these parts together using the M8 bolts, washer and nuts provided. Don't fully tighten these until the exhaust is fitted to the vehicle and is in the correct alignment.
