

Thank you for purchasing a Forge Motorsport Turbo Blanket.

Before starting installation, we recommend obtaining the appropriate safety wear such as gloves and safety glasses. The inside of the blanket may cause skin irritation so be sure to keep away from bare skin. Please also ensure your engine is cooled down if it has recently been running.

As you remove your blanket from the box, ensure that it is kept clean of lubricants and oils as these can sometimes damage the insulating material. If the blanket does come in to contact with these, simply wipe away with a clean cloth.

To ensure longevity of this product, make sure the internal and external maximum temperatures of the blanket are not exceeded. These can be found on our website or by contacting us directly.

The turbo blanket has a short break-in period. During this time, the blanket may give off a distinct smell which will dissipate after a few engine runs*

The Forge turbo blanket will lose its flexibility over the first few heat cycles as the material cures, so once fitted it should not be removed as you will likely damage the blanket.

Please note: whilst our turbo blankets are non-flammable, a flame may be produced when flammable chemicals such as oil or fuel cover the blanket. When installing the blanket, please ensure that there are no leaks within the engine that may cause this to happen.

* In some cases, smoke may be observed during the curing process, (rare, but possible) and will dissipate after one more heat cycle
